

## WVLX Market Report Prime Cattle - 24th Of August, 2020

## Total Yarding: 435

Agents yarded 435 head of cattle at Mortlake this week, with numbers slightly back on the previous sale. The quality of bullocks and grown steers, and steers to the trade were excellent, and there was a very good run of cows of all weights and grades available. All the regular buyers were present, however not not all were fully active, and again there was strong competition from feeders. The market was softer in price by 5c to 10c/kg for grown steers. Yearling heifers and yearling steers, plus grown heifers and cows were easier by 10c to 15c/kg with the light weight cows the most affected. The yarding consisted of 121 bullocks,168 trade cattle, and 146 cows.

*Vealers to the trade made to 430c/kg. Yearling steers to the trade made from 367c to 388c/kg. The heifer portion to the trade made between 325c and 405c, while feeders paid to 378c/kg.* 

The grown steers made from 320c to 396c/kg. The grown heifers made between 295c and 375c, with feeders paying to 394c/kg. Manufacturing steers sold from 268c to 333c/kg. Heavy weight beef bred cows sold from 290c to 314c/kg. Medium weight beef cows sold from 276c to 290c/kg. The very well covered dairy bred cows made between 240c and 244c/kg. Medium weight dairy cows averaged from 210c to 234c/kg. Cows back to the paddock sold to 286c/kg.
