

## WVLX Market Report

### Prime Cattle - 9th Of November, 2020

---

#### **Total Yarding: 841**

Agents yarded 841 cattle at Mortlake which was an increase of 176 head. The overall offering was from very good to excellent. All the regular processors were present and operating as well as feeders,, who were very active in a market that was stronger by 10c to 20c/kg for most categories. Cows however during the sale also sold to a dearer trend from 5c to 10c/kg. The yarding consisted of 195 bullocks, 253 trade cattle, 370 cows and 33 grown bulls.

Milk vealers to the processors made up to 450c/kg. Yearling steers to the trade sold from 373c to 440c, with a heifer portion making from 366c to 446c, feeders paid up to 439c/kg. The grown steers made from 362c to 400c while grown heifers sold from 376c to 387c/kg. Manufacturing steers made from 248c to 370c/kg.

Heavy beef bred cows sold from 300c to 338c/kg. Medium weight beef cows made from 260c to 290c/kg. The very well covered dairy bred cows sold from 240c to 296c/kg. Medium weight dairy bred cows made from 200c to 240c/kg. Cows back to the paddock sold to 285c and the grown beef bulls made to 278c/kg.
