

## WVLX Market Report Prime Cattle - 7th Of December, 2020

Corlindale PTY LTD sold an outstanding pen of Charolais X steers at today's Prime Market. 4 steers going under the hammer for 434c/kg returning \$1475.60 per head. 2 going for 430c/kg returning \$1397.50 and the balance returning just shy of \$1300.00 per head. (Sold By Elders Kerr & Co)

## Total Yarding: 750

Agents penned 750 mainly good quality cattle, 41 fewer, for the regular following of buyers. Demand again weakened for grown steers with prices a further 20c/kg lower. Grown heifers and most cows were close to unchanged in prices with just the beef types unchanged to 10c/kg cheaper. Young cattle sold fully equal for the better quality and up to 10c/kg easier for the average quality.

Milk vealers to the trade sold from 355c to 426c with restockers paying to 434c/kg. Yearling steers made from 360c to 375c with a top sale to 413c with restockers paying to 420c/kg. Yearling heifers sold from 320c to 370c and a single A2 double muscle made 420c/kg. Restockers paid from 340c to 379c/kg for their yearling heifers. The grown steers were mostly selling from 300c to 352c and the manufacturing grades made from 264c to 296c/kg. Grown heifers sold from 278c to 349c/kg. Beef cows made from 280c to 310c with dairy and crossbred cows selling from 255c to 286c/kg.
