

WVLX Market Report

Prime Cattle - 20th of September, 2021

Total Yarding: 477

The usual, plus an additional restocker operated on the reduced offering of 477 plain to good quality cattle, 204 less. Restocker competition put prices up by an average of 20c/kg for young cattle but plainer quality and dairy bred yearlings were on a cheaper trend. Grown steers lifted 20c to 25c/kg and grown heifers sold at unchanged prices. The poor quality cows regained their 50c to 60c loss from last week and beef cows were equal and up to 10c/kg better but the leaner cows sold unchanged to easier.

Light weight vealers to restockers made 544c to 648c and they secured yearling steers between 445c and 62oc/kg. The yearling heifers to restock sold from 45oc to 528c and the few to the trade made 40oc to 472c/kg. Plainer and dairy bred yearling heifers were between 304c and 39oc with restockers paying to 404c/kg.

The grown steers sold from 43oc to 498c and restockers paid 45oc to a top of 524c/kg. Friesian steers made 38oc to 40oc/kg. Grown heifers were between 426c and 46oc/kg.

Beef cows made 350c to 456c and the few dairy cows sold from 350c to 380c with leaner cows between 300c and 350c/kg. The poor to plain conditioned cows made 280c to 340c/kg.
