

WVLX Market Report

Prime Cattle - 25th of October, 2021

Total Yarding: 439

Despite fewer buyers in attendance prices were mainly around the levels of last week, with a few cheaper sales included. Cows were nearly all on an easier trend. The yarding of 439 cattle was 110 less and comprised a mixed selection though many were in finished condition.

The few vealers mainly sold between 562c and 594c while yearlings to the trade made 410c to 580c and restockers paid to 554c and up to 580c/kg for their vealers. The plainer quality and dairy bred yearlings were from 335c to 405c/kg.

Grown steers made 447c to 491c with restockers going to 495c/kg. The older and heavier bullocks sold from 38oc to 425c and Friesians made 38oc/kg. The grown heifers were between 44oc and 465c/kg.

Beef cows sold from 36oc to 42oc and the handful of dairy cows made 365c and 37oc with leaner conditioned cows from 33oc to 36oc/kg. Poor to plain quality cows mainly sold between 27oc and 33oc/kg.
