WVLX Market Report Store Sale - 20th Of January, 2022

Yarding: 6202

There was yet another large yarding of 6202 head of cattle at WVLX Mortlake at the first Store sale of 2022! The sale was considered cheaper overall compared to our December 2021 Store Sale however Agents & Vendors were still very happy with their selling results.

Grown steers sold 20-30c/kg cheaper than last month's sale selling to a top of 596c/kg or to a top head price of \$3312.96 the balance of the portion making between 490c/kg to 555c/kg. Grown Heifers sold to a top of 574c/kg or \$2809.23 averaging out at 480c/kg to 540c/kg.

The Steer & Heifer Weaner Cattle were cheaper given a mixed yarding of weight & types. Weaner steers sold to a top of 780c/kg or \$2530, averaging out at 618c/kg. Weaner heifers sold to similar competition topping out at 742c/kg or \$2281.95, the average being 602c/kg.

The Best Presented Pen Of Steers went to the Farrugia Family which went under the hammer for 598c/kg returning \$2252.69 per head. The Best Presented Pen Of Heifers went to Devondale Family Trust which sold 18 angus heifers for 554c/kg or \$2360.66.

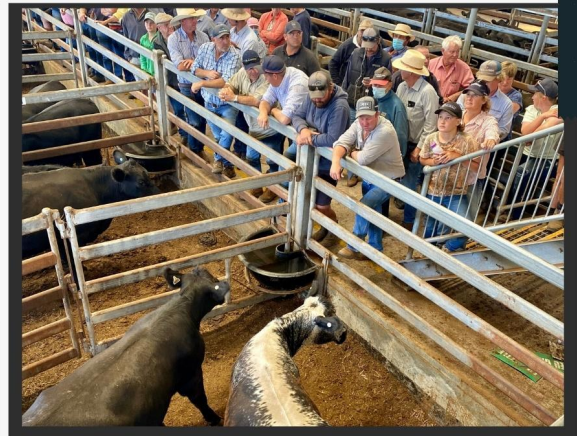
Three Vendors generously donated cattle to be sold at this month's Store Sale with 100% of the proceeds going to The Michelle Pillar Campaign "GIVE EM HELL MICHELLE"! A Speckle Park Heifer & Calf unit donated by Peter & Christine Morris went under the hammer for a whopping \$9600 purchased by Elders Camperdown. Longview Agriculture donated a Simmental X Heifer which was purchased by Charles Stewart Colac for \$3000 and Romsdale Park Donated an Angus Cow & Calf unit which made \$4800 sold to HF Richardson.

There were 145 PTIC Females on offer with the Gublins Family topping the portion at \$3900 for 2nd Calvers. There was a reasonable offering of Friesian and xbred steers comprising 455 head which mostly sold between 350c/kg to 450c/kg topping at 500c/kg.
