

## WVLX Market Report

Prime Cattle - 2nd of May, 2022

## **Total Yarding: 826**

After an absence of 3 weeks, numbers jumped back up to 826 at Mortlake this week where the quality was from very good to plain, more so in the trade cattle offering where 60% of the yarding were purchased to feed on or back to the paddock.

There was a full field of regular buyers present, and not all were fully active in a market that was firm to slightly dearer than the previous sales and quality driven.

There were some excellent vealers offered and they made to 700c/kg averaging 578c/kg. Yearling steers and heifers made to 604c/kg and they averaged 504c/kg with restockers purchasing the most.

Grown steers and heifers sold to a top of 525c/kg and averaged around 425c/kg. Friesian steers sold to 366c/kg.

In a very good offering of cows, predominantly beef bred, the best of these made to 38oc/kg while the general run made between 348-372c/kg. Lighter cows made between 290-348c/kg, dairy cows to 28oc/kg and cows back to the paddock 334-35oc/kg.
