

# WVLX Market Report

## Prime Cattle - 16th of May, 2022

### Total Yarding: 642

Mortlake agents yarded a slight increase in numbers on last sale to 642, comprising of 282 export and 360 trade cattle.

Quality was again good to mixed and a near full field of regular buyers was present but not all fully active. However the market remained firm for all trade cattle and heavy beef bred cows were 10c/kg softer and the better bred cows back to the paddock eased also by 10c/kg. Dairy cows were stronger, making up to 300c/kg.

Vealers with shape sold from 500-588c/kg, yearling steers and heifers 550-577c/kg and the grown steers and heifers sold to a top of 530c/kg.

Manufacturing steers sold to 435c/kg and the best bred cows to 360c/kg, with the general run making between 310 and 360c/kg. The medium cows sold between 234-325c/kg and cows back to the paddock sold from 295-359c/kg.
