

## **WVLX Market Report**

Prime Cattle - 30th of May, 2022

## Total Yarding: 431

Numbers came back this week by 234 head at Mortlake to 431, and this comprised of 208 export and 223 trade cattle. Quality was again good to plain. A near full field of regular buyers was present and mostly fully active.

All trade cattle sold to a fully firm demand. Manufacturing steers also remained firm on low numbers. Beef bred cows were firm to dearer by 20-30c/kg and the dairy cows remained firm.

Vealers with shape sold from 525 to 600c/kg, topping out at 930c/kg. Yearling steers and heifers made between 468 to 562c/kg. Grown steers and heifers sold to a top of 520c/kg, making between 468 and 505c/kg. Manufacturing steers to 356c/kg.

The best beef cows made 384c/kg with the general run making between 300 and 365c/kg. The medium cows 256 to 330c/kg while dairy cows sold for 280 to 330c/kg. The best bred cows back to the paddock sold from 262 to 360c/kg. Bulls sold to a top of 306c/kg.
