



WVLX Market Report Store Sale - 15th of February, 2024

Yarding: 5,380

Mortlake Special Steers store sale yarded 5380, the yarding mostly consisted of Angus bred steers. The quality was mostly excellent with a few pens of plainer secondary types throughout the yarding. A larger field of buyers were on the rail from locally and over Victoria, South Australia, Southern and Northern New South Wales. The market opened firm and became very erratic with larger pen lots of Angus steers selling much dearer at times while smaller plainer lots selling cheaper. Young Angus weaner steers sold 30c to 40c dearer in places while some pen lots sold to 20c cheaper and the Black baldy, Hereford and Euro breeds sold firm to 15c softer. Older grown Angus steers sold firm to 10c dearer in places. The Back Baldy, Hereford and Euro steers were from 5c to 15c cheaper on a fortnight ago levels.

Light weight Angus weaner steers sold from 376c to 448c, medium weights sold from 304c to 420c and heavy weights made from 304c to 396c/kg. Weaner Black Baldy's sold from 328c to 390c/kg. Weaner Hereford steers from 282c to 362c and Euro and Euro cross steers sold from 250c to 356c/kg.

Older Angus steers made from 290c to 374c, Black Baldy steers sold from 300c to 358c/kg. Herefords steers made 256c to 312c and the Euro and Euro cross steers sold from 252c to 326c/kg.
