



WVLX Market Report Store Sale - 4th of April, 2024

Yarding: 848

Numbers were reduced to 848 head at Mortlake store market representing a considerable reduction of 2,580 head compared to the equivalent market a month earlier. There was an improvement in quality although a mixed yarding for type. There was a strong attendance of feed lotters and restockers with the interest improving prices from firm to 20c to 30c/kg stronger in places for weaners and grown cattle. Cows and calves along with PITC Cows were generally softer with limited competition.

Angus weaners steers topped at 344c/kg with black baldy steers selling to 346c/kg. Hereford steers sold to 280c/kg with Speckled steers making 310c/kg. Better grown steers made from 152c to 338c/kg. Grown heifers sold from 270c to 318c/kg with weaner heifers making from 260 to 296c/kg.

Cows and calves, with the calves under two months sold from \$900/unit to \$1400/unit with the PTIC selling from \$880/unit to \$1,100/unit.
